Introduction:

We the students (Number of students: 60) of Tatyasaheb Kore College of Pharmacy, Warananagar visited Primary Healh Centre Sub- Distric Hospital, Kadoli. The hospital is multispecialty hospital. These are complex organization utilizing specialized scientific equipment's & functioning though a team of trained staff educating to the problem of modern medical science.

The hospital staff nurse told us all the information about hospital & its different departments. Prior to the visit he told us about the establishment of hospital & purpose to build the hospital

About the Visit:

Following departments were see in the OPD

- > Reception
- Consulting dept
- Orthopaedics Dept
- > X- Ray Dept
- Pathology Laboratory
- Ophthalmic Dept
- > Pharmacy

The consulting department is for orthopaedics and surgery. Each of the department is headed by MD doctors. Patients after admission in hospital treated by Doctors & in case for diagnostic purpose sent to diagnostic laboratory of hospital .Next we saw the minor & major OT, sterility maintained in the section CSSD Dept which deals with sterilization of different surgical instrument. ICU was also seen by the students & facilities available there. There is eight to ten bed ICU.

There we saw following departments like radio diagnosis which deals with internal photograph of the body which helps to diagnose bone disorder.

Then pathology department was also seen which deals with analysis of blood samples RBCs, WBCs & Hb. The department also deals with analysis of samples like urine, sputum & stool. A histopathology departments which deals with detection of change in tissues caused by diseases.

Patients with minor health problems are treated & send to home with required medicines. Those patients having major health problems should be admitted in hospital . Also we saw general wards, special ward, nursing station for patient care, medical & sanitary departments which takes care of biomedical waste generated hospital. At last we went to hospital pharmacy departments. Pharmacist has more opportunity to interact closely with the prescriber & therefore to promote rational prescribing & drug use also pharmacist can effectively perform duties like patient monitoring, patient counselling & record maintenance

While discussing the administration of hospital, they told us the staff pattern
